**Tengfei Liu** received the B.E. degree in Automation and the M.E. degree in Control Theory and Control Engineering from South China University of Technology, in 2005 and 2007, respectively. He received the Ph.D. degree in Engineering from the Australian National University in 2011. From 2011 to 2013, Tengfei Liu was a visiting assistant professor at Polytechnic Institute of New York University (now Polytechnic School of Engineering at New York University). Since 2014, Tengfei Liu has been a professor with Northeastern University, China. His research interests include stability

theory, robust nonlinear control, quantized control, distributed control and their applications in mechanical systems, power systems and transportation systems.

Dr. Liu, with Z. Jiang and D. J. Hill, received the "Guan Zhao-Zhi" Best Paper Award at the 2011 Chinese Control Conference.
